## How it's made and the properties

The finest raw Quartz mineral is mined in India's largest quarry by Baba Quartz, with the capacity to produce 300 tonnes of material per day. Baba Quartz is a transnational corporation with import centres spanning from East Asia to Dubai and Italy. There are two crushing processes and an intelligent Gyro Screen machine is used for the consistency of sizing. The final exported raw product has been trialled and tested through several standard chemical tests in a master laboratory, along with rigorous manual inspection executed by highly trained quality control experts. The Quartz is manufactured under the belief that a healthy environment is not only complimentary, but critical to a healthy business. The mission is to develop a high performance, high value product, whilst ensuring all production is carried out in an environmentally safe and eco-friendly manner.

Artscut exclusively sources its resins from exotic Brazil, the markets leading innovator in polymer resin technology and engineering. The patented technology, is employed to engineer the elements of the composite stone. The slabs are pressed together using the vibro-compression vacuum process that leaves the most secure and non-porous finished product.

Reflecting of the globalised market we exist in today, Artscut takes pride in incorporating the worldwide labour force. The raw materials pass through the skilled hands of craftsmen from Asia, Europe, North America and beyond. Artscut transcends borders to bring you the perfect mixture of the world's finest ingredients that will become the art at the centre of your home.

This mineral is what constitutes 93% of the Artscut stone. The remaining seven percent is contrived of colour pigments and polymer resins.

## Step by step

### → Feeding and mixing

The raw materials (quartz, pigments and polymers) are carefully selected, tested and then mixed together.

### → Moulding and pressing

The mixture is then poured into a mould and formed into slabs. It is compressed under very high pressure (nearly 100 tons psi) and vibrated in a vacuum. This removes all the air and creates a compressed surface.

### → Curing

The slabs are then moved to the curing kiln and heated to 90°C for 45 minutes which provides the finished levels of strength and solidity.

### → Polishing

The slabs are gauged, calibrated and then polished to a perfect finish in a wide range of colours and designs.

### → Quality testing

Every slab then undergoes rigorous quality testing to ensure it meets our extremely high standards of color, hue and consistency.

### → Tagging

The slabs are then labeled, sorted and tagged, and enter our distribution system to ensure they reach our customers in perfect condition.



# Artscut Warranty

## 25 years warranty on all our products

Artscut warrants to the residential owner-occupants of installed Artscut slab surfaces a 25 year warranty from the date of purchase by the original owner or installer whichever is earlier.

The quartz warranty covers any manufacturing defects and if any manufacturing defect occurs during the warranty period, we will repair or replace the defective Artscut slabs.

Customers are advised to read and understand the maintenance instructions of our stone.

Artscut 25-year quartz warranty is available to anyone who has recently had a Artscut slab installed in their homes or premises by approved fabricators and distributors, along with fitter invoice.

## What this warranty does not cover

### Cracks

Artscut slabs are stone products which will not crack unless an external force or interaction causes the crack such as impacts, uneven cabinets or flooring, structural settling or movements, thermal shock from the use of crock pots, skillets or other hot items placed directly on the Artscut slabs, improper installation or other conditions in the home that may cause the Artscut surfaces to shift. Therefore, cracks are not covered by this warranty.

Caution: Do not use crock pots, skillets or other hot items directly on your Artscut surfaces. Always place them on a trivet or cutting board to protect your Artscut from thermal shock.

### Abnormal Use or Abuse

This warranty does not cover products exposed to abnormal use or conditions or abuse in any way. "Abnormal use or conditions" includes, but is not limited to, damage from mishandling or misuse, damage from excessive heat, scorching or exposure to weather conditions, exposure to ultraviolet light, physical or chemical abuse, acid etching, staining or damage from improper care and maintenance or damage from chipping, cracking, impact damage or breaking due to customer abuse.

### Temporary Marks

This warranty does not cover temporary marks on the Artscut products including but not limited to metal marks, fingerprints or smudges or other temporary marks made by household utensils.

### Variations in Colour

This warranty does not cover temporary marks on the Artscut products including but not limited to metal marks, fingerprints or smudges or other temporary marks made by household utensils.

### Normal Wear and Tear

This warranty shall apply to Artscut, except however, this warranty does not cover normal wear and tear that occurs over time including but not limited to minor dents and scratches from pots and pans, cuts and nicks, scuff marks, chipping, pouring boiling water without cold water, use of dry ice or any other uses that do not comply with the Care and Maintenance.
